DO

- √ Keep to the speed limit
- √ Drive safely & considerately
- √ Wear a seat belt and ensure your passengers do as well
- √ Keep to roads and car park areas
- ✓ Keep away from quay edges
- √ Be guided by BPC staff as to where to park
- √ Be prepared to stop if required by Port Police/Port Personnel
- √ Keep clear of working areas and plant & equipment unless necessary for your business. Use headlights whenever possible
- √ Report any suspicious activity

DO NOT

- ★ Get out of your vehicle in working areas unless wearing PPE
- × Smoke (including E-Cigarettes)
- × Endanger yourself or others
- X Park on double yellow lines or where you may cause an obstruction
- × Drive near working equipment
- Bring unauthorised persons onto the port
- X Drive whilst using a hand held mobile phone
- X Drink and drive on the port
- X Ignore anything unsafe, report it to Port Police/Port Personnel
- × Use hazard lights unless you need help

TAXI & VISITING DRIVER INFORMATION

Your safety and that of your passengers is our priority whilst you are on our port. Please follow the rules and guidance shown on this document and have a safe visit.

Keep your vehicle well away from our operational quay sides as these are unprotected and there are deep water hazards at all our berths. There have been serious accidents in UK ports involving taxis/visitors in the past.

There are very large items of plant moving around the port, they may not see you so don't assume that they have

Do not walk around and do not allow your passengers to walk around operational areas.

Port Bylaws replicate the Road Traffic Act. Adhere to the rules in the same way as you would on public roads. However, extra care should be taken as there are many more hazards on the port than on public roads.

Use your headlights and ensure you are seen by our port operators, use indicators to show your intentions so keep hazard lights off unless you need help.
