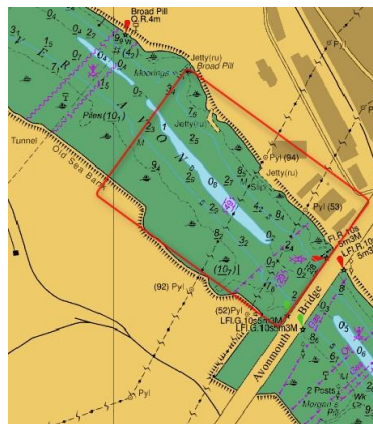
**RIVER AVON - RIVER CLOSURE**

**PYLON CONDUCTOR INSTALLATION WORKS**  
**24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2024 – 0700 hrs to 1800 hrs**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that pylon conductor installation operations will be undertaken across the River Avon on **24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> February 2024 between 0700 and 1800 hours on both days**

**DUE TO THE NATURE OF THE WORKS**  
**THE RIVER AVON WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL RIVER TRAFFIC**  
**BETWEEN THE TIMES STATED ABOVE.**

**Area of Operation**

The works will be undertaken within the red rectangle (north-west of the M5 Avonmouth Bridge), as shown on the Admiralty Chart 1859 (Panel A) extract below:



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All vessels, regardless of LOA or tonnage, navigating the River Avon less than 4 hours before both closures are to notify Bristol VTS of their intentions on VHF Ch.12

The river will be closed as the works will reduce the safe vertical clearance heights under the pylons.
